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Our Government Renewed its Pledge for Adult Basic Education

At the end of the 2017-18 school year, the provincial government renewed its commitment to adult basic education.

Adult Basic Education (ABE) is a key priority for VCCFA members. We have been working with the Ministry of Advanced Education and Skills Training to make sure that adult basic education is accessible and affordable. We will continue to work with the Ministry to ensure that ABE remains a priority for the province.

- i. **Pathways**: Continue the work of the ABE Task Force to develop pathways to post-secondary education and the labour market for adults.
- ii. **Financial Assistance**: Implement a new financial assistance program for adult basic education students.
- iii. **Curriculum**: Develop a new curriculum for adult basic education that is more accessible and affordable.
- iv. **Restoration of Funding**: Restore funding to Adult Basic Education and English language learning.
- v. **Implementation of a Proven Approach**: Implement a proven approach to improving access to adult basic education.

The provincial government has committed to providing additional funding for adult basic education. This funding will be used to support the implementation of the new financial assistance program and the development of a new curriculum.

We are grateful to the provincial government for renewing its commitment to adult basic education.

We will continue to work with the Ministry of Advanced Education and Skills Training to ensure that adult basic education remains a priority for the province.

2 Assessment and Recommendations

2.1. Approach

We conducted our assessment during March 2014, and undertook the following procedures:

- a. Obtained the information of the other institutions from their websites (e.g. # of students, # of campus locations, annual revenue and # of programs) and evaluated them against VCC for similarity Refer to Appendix A for the Institutions Comparative Chart.
- b. Mapped the spending authority limits of VCC W K H L Q V W L W X W L R Q V W K D W D U H in the step a). Refer to Appendix Comparison with Similar Institutions
- c. Mapped the spending authority limits of VCC W K H L Q V W L W X W L R Q V W K D W D U H V L P L O D U μ L R Q V W K D W D U H Refer to Appendix Comparison with Somewhat Similar Institutions
- d. Analyed the benchmarking charts in Appendices B and C
- e. Developed a new spending authority matrix that is considered reasonable based on the benchmarking exercise

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

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
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Hi Ysabel!
